ACTIVITIES

Providing Training courses to inform women of the civil laws to which they relate.

Providing Training courses for women of all ages in various fields such as computer courses and others.

Participate in many of private and peaceful coexistence training courses and get many testimonials within this area.

Establishment of art and drawing courses for children and encourage talented of them.

Rehabilitation of some of the displaced children (beggars) and advancement of their work to other jobs and re-some of them to schools.

Participation in the liberation of Nineveh conferences and carry out many field visits to areas liberated.

Founding member of Forum of Support the insistence of women.

Distributed NFIs (hygiene and dignity) for the IDPs in Hamam Al Alil camp and in Nargazia camp covered 1,200 Household.

Distributed Foods to people in need, women, widows, and divorcees in Jada'a and Al Khazir camps for 4,000 Households.

Provided water and food in screening centers for newly displaced families from Mosul and the villages around for all the period of the Iraqi operation to retake the city.

Prepared and trained youth volunteers on emergency response in cases of displacement.

Mercy Corps: Establishing festival "Yes to peace" community reconciliation supported by Mercy Corps.

Distributed stories books against Violence in camps and outside camps.

Reconstruction of government buildings in Ninewa like @Alqudis department for computers and @Planning and Follow-up department by windows and doors.

Provided computers to Talkief General Library & Al-Qyarra municipalities in Ninewa.

Support poor families those have vulnerabilities by provide them cash assistant to build the roofs for their houses.

UNICEF: Partner with UNICEF on Child protection in Mosul (East and west) and Talkief schools to work on:

- Psychosocial support for girls, boys and caregivers through school and community-based activities including child and youth resilience trainings.
- Strengthening national and local capacity to provide sustained child protection services
- Trainings (teachers);
- Identification and response to individual child protection concerns through specialized services
- Case management and Referrals.
- Awareness raising and advocacy on key identified child protection issues.

UNICEF: Worked on Child protection project in Ninewa – east Mosul for five schools and the fund from UNICEF.

Care International: Partner with Care Organization and Hope Organization is distributed Hygiene items, Dignity kits for women and baby kits in Mosul on daily basis. Also provided hygiene promotion in Mosul for People.

Distributed drink water for newly displaced people from West and East of Mosul.

Distributed 400 blankets for families in Al Samah neighborhood.

Conducted assessment for wash projects in Mosul water station.

Set up 4 Water feeding plugs in the main water station in West of Mosul.

Provided awareness sessions about cholera and on hand borne diseases and germs.

UNICEF: Distributing Warm Clothes for children from 0-14 Years covering, Sinjar Mountain, Sinjar and Bashiqa, funded by UNICEF for 23,000 Children.

Care International: Livelihoods project in Talafar for Strengthening WASH basic infrastructure, resilience and livelihoods in return areas in Ninewa, Iraq. This project is ongoing in Talafar district for three years starting from Dec-2018 funded by Care International. The components of this project are;

- WASH sensitization sessions: providing awareness sessions to the community.
- Rehabilitation/construction of water structures.
- Boreholes/water pipes.
- Vocational trainings for the community in Talafar.
- Providing business start-up kits.
- Cash for Work activities: CFW wages and providing tools, equipment and protective clothes.
- Providing legal services and awareness sessions.
- Participatory Approach for local authorities.



Mercy Corps: Cash for Work project, funded by Mercy Corps in Wana-Ninewa, in the beginning of 2019 for five days to rubble lift and wide cleaning campaign.

UNDP: Project title; “forming local popular committees in Ninewa, Mosul and Bartilla”. Started from 15/9/2018 to 15/12/2018. This project aimed to build / strength the reliable partnership with the local police in Ninewa in order protect the rights of citizens and cooperation.

UPP:Project title; “ Bridging communities in the Ninewa Plains”Two separate projects started on 25/4/2019 in areas characterized by ethnic and religious diversity. The aim of the project is to build a peaceful society free from sectarian violence and intolerance. The ceremony was held at the Church of Mar in KaramLiss After Ramadam, teams from several districts were prepared to participate in the girls’ volleyball tournament

IREX: Education project funded by IREX aims to monitor 30 schools for 3 months starting from Mar-2019. Hope Organization will support monitoring and evaluation of the Education for Coexistence program through a series of coordinated site visits for observation of participating educators.
